

HKRU CLUB COVID MANAGER ROLE



It is required that each club appoints a COVID Manager for the 2020/2021 rugby season. The COVID Manager must complete an online education module on the management of COVID-19, and act as a point of contact between HKRU and their respective club or team.

THE COVID MANAGER IS EXPECTED TO

- Complete the HKRU Club Checklist for their own club/team,
- Ensure that their club/ team is operating in a safe manner and is adhering to both HK government and HKRU guidelines
- Act as a contact point for players or members of their rugby club on matters relating to COVID-19 management matters
- Work with HKRU Medical department in ensuring best practices are implemented at each individual club.

This role is well suited to a club volunteer who is medically trained, but medical training is not essential. It could be a new volunteer, or an existing volunteer could take on this role as an additional task.

Each Club's COVID Manager must complete both of these online education modules.
