The foundation runs 3 programmes in schools using rugby as a medium to build confidence in communication in English by creating an immersive environment with sessions run by native English speaking coaches, and specially created syllabuses. We partner with British Council, who assist with the design of the resource materials, staff training, and evaluation. Rugby English Action Learning (REAL) - the Foundation has been offering REAL with the support of the Education Bureau (Scolar) since 2007 to local primary schools. Over 30 schools each year participate, with a long waiting list!
