THIS PROGRAMME AIMS TO ENHANCE THE EMPLOYABILITY OF YOUNGSTERS FINISHING SECONDARY SCHOOL EDUCATION AND HELP THEM TO GAIN MORE EXPERIENCE IN WORKING IN THE SPORTS INDUSTRY.

The Foundation has 2 groups on apprentice programmes - 4 Operation Breakthrough graduates are supported by Ageas, with another 4 from ethnic minority backgrounds are supported by the Kadoorie Foundation. All participants are offered 12 month contracts with HKRU, and during that time they receive mentoring and support as well as the opportunity to attend training courses, to help equip them for a future career in the sports industry.



Coaching in SEN schools was a challenge because I've never work with Special Ed. Students before. It was really fun and exciting to see the kids enjoy rugby. I learnt quite a lot during the HK7s, like how everything has to be on schedule and how to better manage the workforce of the delivery team.
