HONG KONG'S RUGBY SPIRIT

THIS PROGRAMME AIMS TO TEACH YOUNGSTERS ABOUT THE VALUES OF RUGBY AS WELL AS UNDERSTANDING MORE ABOUT THEIR NATIONAL IDENTITY THROUGH FUN AND ACTIVE GAMES.

This initiative, sponsored by UBS and Laureus Sport for Good Foundation, focuses on the 7 priority values that the Education Bureau have identified for Hong Kong students: 'Perseverance' (Determination), 'Respect for Others', 'Responsibility', 'National Identity', 'Commitment', 'Integrity' (Honesty) and 'Care for Others' (Teamwork). The course material was developed in the conjunction with the Father Cucchiara Memorial School Principal, and has been endorsed by both the Education Bureau and Chinese University's Department of Education. There are currently over 80 local primary schools enrolled.
